The Celebration of Sunday Mass

If you are returning to Mass after an absence, welcome back, you may notice some changes. Currently the safe number of people attending a Mass in our church is **60**. If on arrival you find the church is full please consider an alternative time or a weekday Mass instead. The Sunday obligation remains suspended.

On entering and leaving the church please use the hand sanitizer provided. 'Track and trace' regulations require us to record the names and contact details of those attending, so if possible please write your name plus address/email/phone number on a piece of paper in advance, and include the time of Mass you are attending. We will also have cards available which people can fill on arrival at church.

Mass will be shorter than usual for a Sunday. Congregational singing is not allowed and there will be no prayers of the faithful. Instead of an offertory collection two boxes are available near the sanctuary for your donations. Where possible you are requested to donate online, through our JustGiving page, or by Standing Order.

When coming forward for Holy Communion, please leave a reasonable space to the person in front and to the minister when receiving. Please allow extra time and space for people with a disability and return to your place by the side aisles only. At the end of Mass you may exit by the main or side doors; please allow adequate spacing with other parishioners. Thank you.
