Safety Procedures at Mass

It is now a legal requirement to wear a face covering when in church.

Currently the safe number spaces in our church is **60**. If on arrival you find the church is full please come at an alternative time or a weekday Mass instead if you wish. The Sunday obligation remains suspended.

On entering and leaving the church please use the hand sanitizer provided. 'Track and trace' regulations require us to record the names and contact details of those attending, so where possible, please write your name plus address or email or phone number on a piece of paper in advance, and include the time of Mass you are attending. We will also have cards available which people can fill on arrival at church, or you can download a card along with this week's newsletter which you can print and complete at home.

Congregational singing is not allowed and there are no prayers of the faithful. Instead of an offertory collection two boxes are available for your donations, one near the sanctuary and one at the back of the church. Where possible you are requested to donate online, through our JustGiving page, or by Standing Order. Should you need them, our bank details are: NatWest, Account 44136757, Sort Code 60-23-19.

When coming forward for Holy Communion, please come one bench at a time, start with the front row on

the left-hand side of the church (as you face the altar) and finishing with the last row on the right-hand side. Please leave at least one metre space to the person in front and also to the minister when receiving. Please allow extra time and space for people with a disability and return to your place by the side aisles only.

At the end of Mass please exit by side door again, a row at a time allowing adequate spacing with other parishioners. Should you wish to visit the repository, please stay in your bench until the church has emptied and then queue, observing social distance.

During these difficult times, please say your private prayers either before Mass or at home afterwards, so that the church can be cleaned immediately after each Mass. Thank you.
