- Note the safe number spaces in our church is **60**.
 - Note the Sunday obligation remains suspended.
 - Use the one-way system in the church.
 - Remember to leave at least one metre social distancing.

 - Put your offering in the two boxes provided.

 - Form the Holy Communion procession starting with the front row on the left-hand side (as you face the altar) and finishing with the last row on the right-hand side.
 - Exit via the side door or the back door, using the one-way system, at the end of Mass.
 - Should you wish to visit the repository (Christmas items now in stock), stay in your bench until the church has emptied and then queue.
 - Pray privately either before Mass or at home, so that the church can be cleaned immediately after each Mass.
