Safety procedures at Mass. Please note:

- the safe number of spaces in our church is **60**
- the Sunday obligation remains suspended
- use the one-way system in the church
- it is a legal requirement to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt) over your mouth and nose
- leave at least one metre social distancing

- complete a 'Test and Trace' card
- put your offering in one of the two boxes provided

- social conversations in the church are not permitted during lockdown

Day for Victims of Trafficking: Monday 8 February is the memorial of St Josephine Bakhita, the patroness of survivors of slavery. Please pray for those affected by the crimes of modern slavery and human trafficking, and the people that volunteer and work to eradicate this crime. There are an estimated 40 million victims of modern slavery worldwide. Modern slavery affects every country in the world, and here in the UK figures suggest there are in excess of 100,000 victims hidden in plain sight. Modern slavery now ranks as the second most profitable worldwide criminal enterprise.

This cause is very close to Bishop Patrick Lynch's heart, who on his retirement kindly asked for donations to be made for the Day for Victims of Trafficking in lieu of any retirement gifts.
