Safety procedures at Mass. Please note:

- the safe number of spaces in our church is **60**
- the Sunday obligation remains suspended
- use the one-way system in the church

- social conversations in the church are not permitted during lockdown

Second collection this Sunday 14 February is to support poorer parishes in the diocese. The second collection on Sunday 21 February will be taken to support the Victims of Trafficking cause.

Ash Wednesday: please note that we will be having two additional Masses in the evening, at 18.00 and 19.30. Given limited numbers allowed in the church, please try to attend one of these evening Masses to minimise numbers. Please also note that this year the dry ash will be sprinkled on the top of our heads.

Stations of the Cross will be celebrated every Friday in Lent at 19.30 in the church. This will be open to the public and also live streamed on our website. We are looking for three volunteers for each service to bear the cross and candles around the church. Please contact the parish office if you would like to volunteer.

Confessions in Lent will be heard every Wednesday 19.00-20.00 and Saturdays 9.00-10.00 by two priests, one in the sacristy and the other in Our Lady's chapel. Lenten penitential service will not be organised this year. Please find copies of *Examinations of Conscience* at the back of the church and on the website. We encourage you to come to Reconciliation throughout Lent and not to leave this until Holy Week.
