**Safety procedures at Mass.** Please note:

- the safe number of spaces in our church is **60**
- the Sunday obligation remains suspended
- use the one-way system in the church
- it is a legal requirement to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt) over your mouth and nose
- leave at least one metre social distancing
- use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit
- complete a 'Test and Trace' card
- put your offering in one of the two boxes provided
- where possible, donate online, through our JustGiving page or by standing order. Bank details: NatWest, account 44136757, sort code 60-23-19
- form the Holy Communion procession starting with the front row (facing the altar) on the left-hand side finishing with the last row on the right-hand side
- exit via the side or back door, using the one-way system, at the end of Mass
- the repository is now closed
- pray privately before Mass, so that the church can be cleaned immediately after each Mass
- social conversations in the church are not permitted during lockdown

Please note that **ONLINE BOOKINGS ARE REQUIRED for all Masses and services listed above and listed in the Easter leaflet.** Please book these via the parish website. If you cannot access the website, please contact the parish office (Mon/Wed/Fri, 10.30-16.00). Please book only one Mass/service per day. All listed services will also be live streamed on the parish website.
