- the safe number of spaces in our church is **60**
- the Sunday obligation remains suspended
- use the one-way system in the church
- it is a legal requirement to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt) over your mouth and nose

- note, should you wish to visit the repository, stay in your bench until the church has emptied and then queue
- pray privately before Mass, so that the church can be cleaned immediately after each Mass
