Safety procedures at Mass. Please note:

- the safe number of spaces in our church is **60**
- the safe number of spaces in JP Centre is **12**
- the Sunday obligation remains suspended
- use the one-way system in the church and JP Centre
- it is a legal requirement to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt) over your mouth and nose
- leave at least one metre social distancing
- use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit
- complete a 'Test and Trace' card
- put your offering in one of the two boxes provided
- where possible, donate online, through our JustGiving page or by standing order. Bank details: NatWest, account 44136757, sort code 60-23-19
- form the Holy Communion procession starting with the front row on the left-hand side (facing the altar) finishing with the last row on the right-hand side
- exit via the side or back door, using the one-way system, at the end of Mass
- note, should you wish to visit the repository, stay in your pew until the church has emptied, or make your way from JP Centre to the church and then queue
- pray privately before Mass, so that the church and JP Centre can be cleaned immediately after each Mass
