World Day of the Sick: will take place on Sunday 11 February. Pope Francis requests for prayers and a commitment to the terminally ill and their families in the February edition of The Pope Video. The Holy Father shares this prayer intention during the month in which, on 11 February, the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, the World Day of the Sick takes place, which was established in 1992 by John Paul II. Pope Francis explains that "when some people talk about terminal illnesses, there are two words they often confuse: incurable and un-careable. But they are not the same." Citing John Paul II, Pope Francis affirms, "Cure if it is possible; always take care", in the video message he addresses to every believer through the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network.
