John Paul Association: the JPA is a welcoming group of older parishioners who meet socially on Mondays in the JP Centre. The sessions start with a chat and a hot drink with biscuits followed by board or card games. Their last meeting before Easter will be held on 31 March at 14.00 – all are welcome. Thereafter, meetings will recommence on Monday 28 April at 14.00 until they break for summer on 14 July (ex bank holidays).
