What is Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament? And why is it being promoted in our parish soon. Find out at Masses on the weekend of 22/23 November.

Please note the additional Masses to be celebrated on All Souls' Day. This commemoration is not a Holy Day of Obligation – it's rather an encouragement to pray for our departed relatives and friends.

Holy Souls: At the back of the church you will find the lists for the names of your deceased relatives and friends, which you can leave with one of the priests. We will pray for them during the Rosary Adoration on Saturdays 1, 8, 15 and 23 November after the evening Mass.
